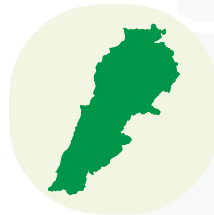

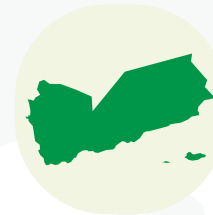

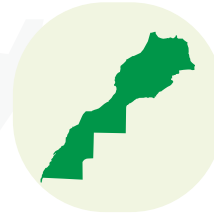

HIGHLIGHTS



EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Mercy Without Limits is dedicated to providing aid following emergency situations; the earthquakes in Syria, Turkiye, Morocco and the floods in Libya in 2023 were among the disasters that we were active in enacting emergency relief humanitarian projects.

Given our teams and resources in the region, we were able to act swiftly following the massive earthquakes in Syria and Turkiye. With the help of our local staff, we distributed food, water, hygiene kits, and provided shelter in the form of tents; for victims of the disaster.

Quickly following the devastating earthquake that hit Morocco in September, our team worked to bring urgent relief to families who had been affected. We built emergency shelters and provided aid to those in need of support.

We distributed food baskets, mattresses, blankets and stoves, and constructed tents following the disaster.

The massive floods in Libya also required immediate action to help displaced families and individuals in the affected regions. MWL made it our priority to extend our reach to victims of the disaster, supplying them with aid in the forms of food and daily essentials.

BUILDING EVALUATION

Our local team partnered with the association of Syrian Engineers to inspect and classify the extent of damage to buildings in Northern Syria. We completed inspection of 100% of the structures in question in the greater Aleppo area – 161,740 homes and 41,884 commercial buildings.

This project has been internationally recognized for its overarching benefit to communities in the region. MWL was honored to receive inquiries from the UN as they look to conduct similar programs to help rebuild and restore after the disaster.

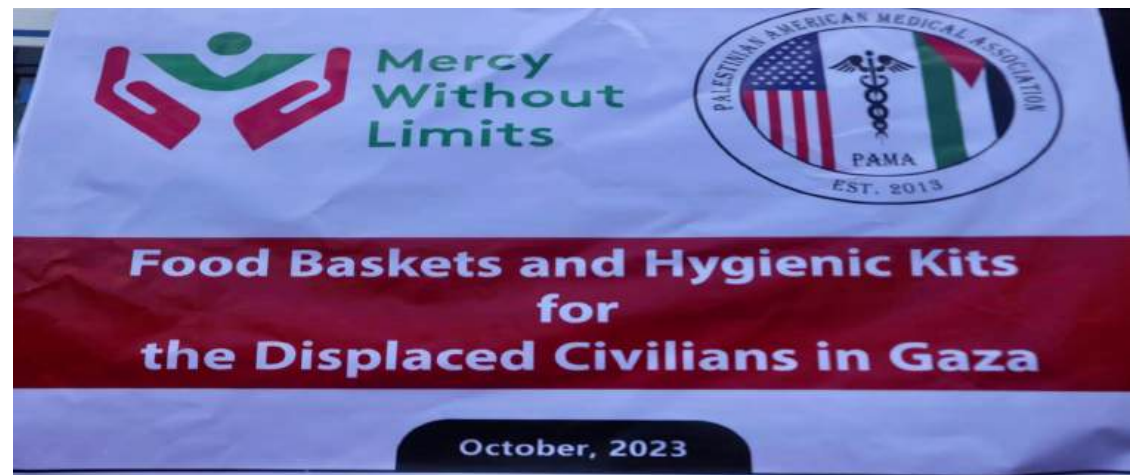

PROTECTION

It is a prioritized focus of humanitarian organizations worldwide to care for children's physical and mental health. MWL is taking part in this mission by partnering with humanitarian agencies to conduct projects worldwide. Child protection programs MWL is involved in include recreational activities, structured and semi-structured psychosocial support, and awareness campaigns focusing on subjects like personal hygiene and education. Our protection projects spanned across Jordan, Syria and Lebanon and included activities such as awareness sessions, PSS activities, training courses, rehabilitation of CWD facilities, referrals and cash support. A total of around 121K beneficiaries were reached through our protection projects.

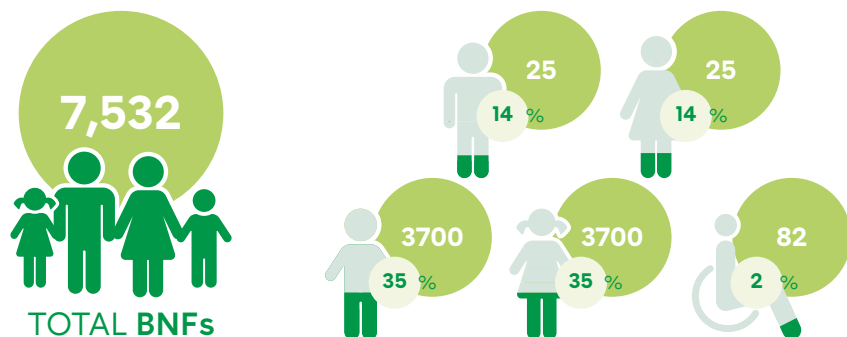
CHILD PROTECTION

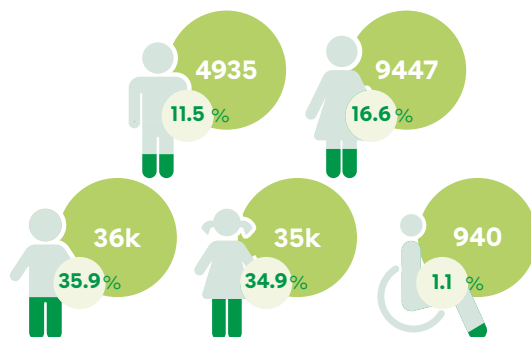
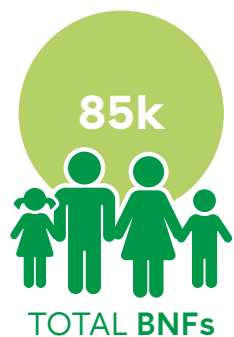

EDUCATION

Mercy Without Limits strongly believes in the mission to bring education to underserved communities across the globe. Equipping children and adults with the necessary tools they need to develop their knowledge and skills will enable them to bring about lasting change to their community. Achieving this goal also enables individuals to be self-sustained through their own talents and abilities, they have been able to develop through their education.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, dropout rates increased due to sickness, conflicts, poverty, and loss of wealth and family. MWL works towards solving the global education crisis by implementing a variety of education projects, meeting the vast demands of basic educational needs, such as learning kits, rehabilitation schools, teachers' incentives, etc. Accelerated learning programs have also been made available as an option to disadvantaged children to provide them with equivalent educational standards to match their age. Children with special needs were served in all projects, maintaining equal opportunity for all children to learn.

Our education projects spanned across five countries, Türkiye, Syria, Bangladesh, Lebanon, Jordan and Palestine. We rehabilitated water supply systems for education facilities, provided sanitation services, constructed classrooms, provided training to local teachers, distributed textbooks, school bags and hygiene kits to students, and supplied fuel for heating to schools during the winter months.

WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE **WASH**

In 2023, many communities worldwide suffered with a lack of water and means to maintain adequate hygiene. To improve health and community conditions MWL was grateful to take part in constructing water wells and orchestrating projects that enabled access to safe water and sanitation in several countries. Over this past year we built wells, provided water trucking, supplied clean water tanks and latrines and established sewer systems and water networks; helping around 290,000 beneficiaries across 93,000 households in Bangladesh, Türkiye, Syria and Lebanon.

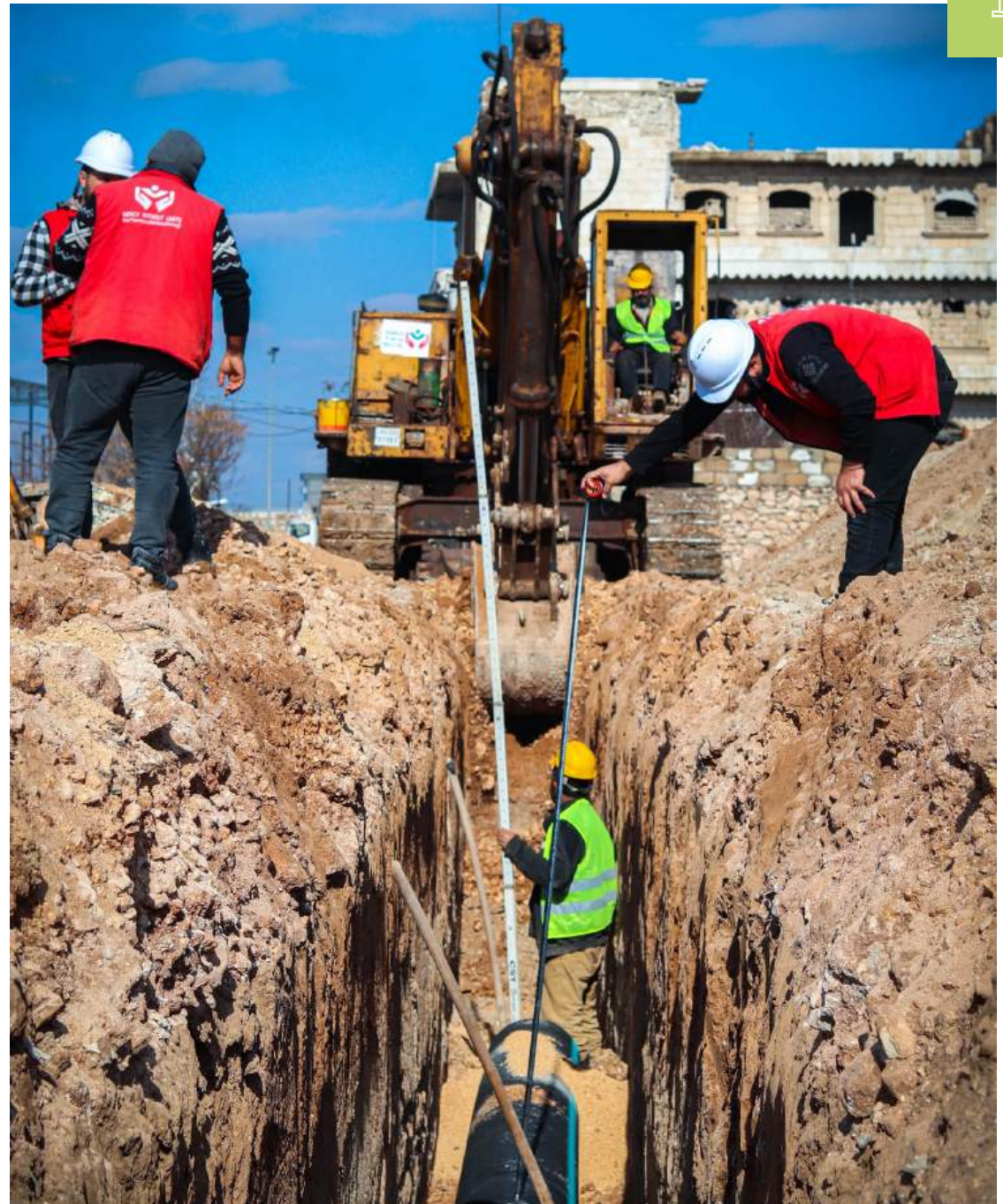
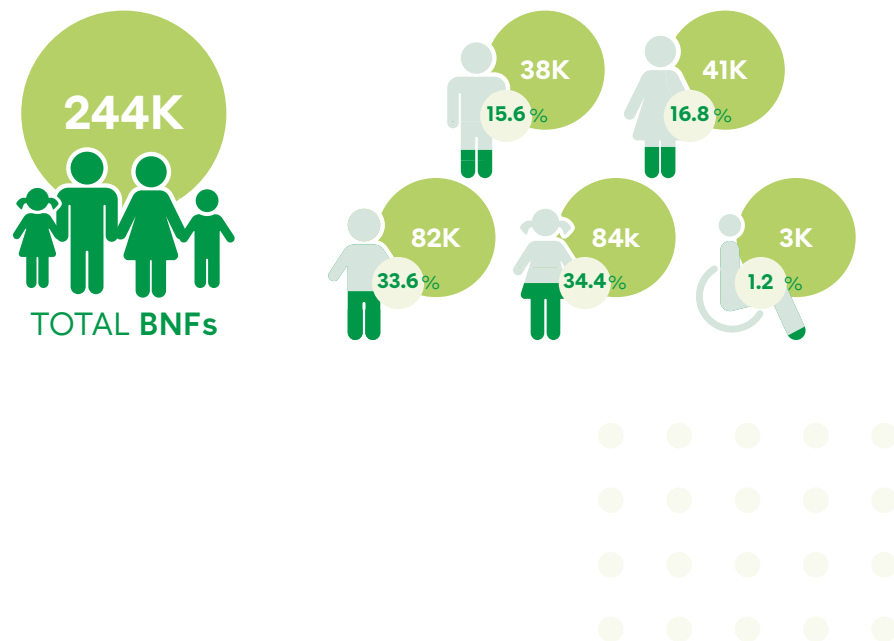

SHELTER-NFI

People worldwide who have been displaced and lost their homes due to tragedy or disaster have found themselves without adequate shelter. MWL provides tents and living quarters to Rohingya Refugees in Bangladesh, and people who have been displaced by natural disasters in Türkiye, Syria, and Morocco. Shelters were implemented to expand shelter capacity and improve living conditions to help facilitate survival. Among our projects for shelter, our teams were able to rehabilitate homes, install tents for displaced families, distribute pillows, mattresses, carpets and fuel for heaters.
